

The first days of a new school year are full of excitement and learning new schedules. Keep in mind that traffic on campus during drop off and pick up will be heavy the first 2 weeks of school. We greatly appreciate our community's kindness and patience as we work diligently to safely transfer your child/ren to and from vehicles. Feel free to thank the teachers who are working in 100+ degree temps. Plan to leave earlier in the mornings to account for the slower lines on campus. Please note, students may enter campus beginning at 7:20 am and may not be dropped sooner.

# **Kindergarten Half Days**

All Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 12 noon the first three days of school, Monday, August 5th-Wednesday, August 7th. Athenaeum will not be available for after school care. Please make arrangements to pick up your Kindergarten student at noon.

#### **5th Grade Immunizations**

In accordance with Arizona State Law (A.R.S 15-872), students must have proof of all required immunizations, or a valid exemption in order to attend school.

It is also a requirement for students, 11 years and older, to receive the Meningococcal and Tdap vaccines. The Meningococcal vaccine provides protection against the Meningitis Bacteria and the Tdap vaccine provides protection against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough).

As your child turns 11, please schedule an appointment with their healthcare provider to receive these vaccinations. Please bring in proof of these vaccinations to the front desk when you receive them.

### **Nut Free Classrooms**

As we begin our new school year, please be aware that your child's classroom may become a nut free environment. In order to protect our students, we ask that you refrain from packing snacks that contain nuts as an ingredient until we have identified all of our students that have a severe nut allergy. This may take up to two weeks. Your teacher will be in contact with you to let you know if your child's classroom is "nut free". Thank you very much for your cooperation.
